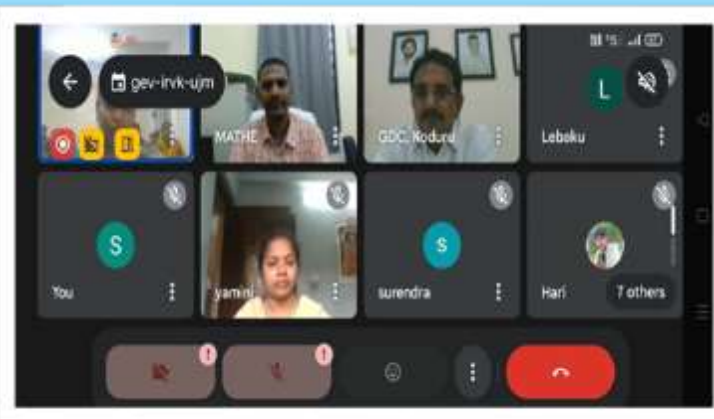
International Day Against Drug Abuse
