7th APSPA International Conference :

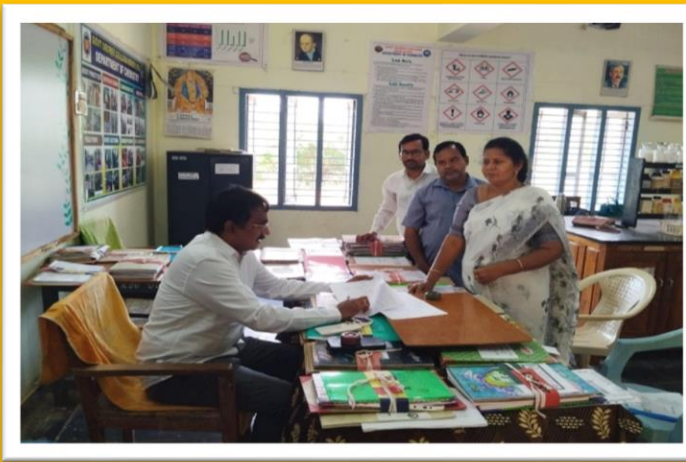
