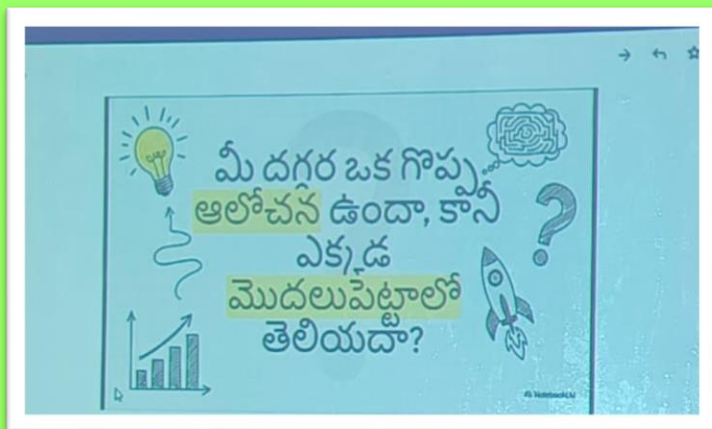
## Awareness Programme on Voters Day

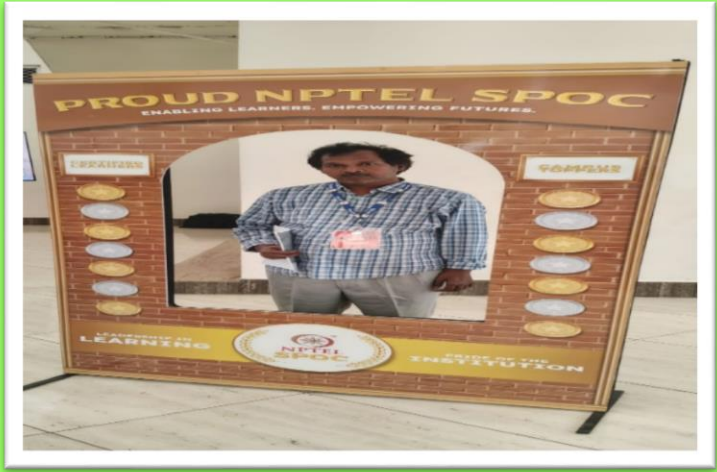
## Superannuation of Record Assistant
